LAKEFRONT RENTERS:



Our pond is free of invasive milfoil, which can grow from very tiny pieces. Please clean any boats and other watercraft - away from the water - brought in from use in other waters. Maine's has a new Clean, Drain, Dry law to stop the spread of invasives.

Live bait, including worms, is not allowed in this pond. Fishing is restricted to artificial lures only.



It is against Maine law to use soaps, shampoos, cleansers, etc. in the lakes and waters.

Fire permits are required. Call the Dedham/Lucerne Fire Department. Fireworks are allowed July 3 & 4, 12:00 noon - 10:30 p.m. only.



LOONS! Enjoy these beautiful birds from a distance. Adults can defend themselves, but babies cannot. If you get too close to nests, you may cause them to abandon eggs. Also please retrieve any fishing line or rope from the water and do not use lead sinkers.
